NUSIP Application Checklist

Before starting the application procedure, please check your eligibility and the documentation.

Eligibility

- Applicants MUST be enrolled in universities having concluded academic exchange agreements
 with Nagoya University at the inter-university level or with the Graduate School of Engineering
 at the inter-school level. However, maximum of 5 students from the universities NOT having
 concluded academic exchange agreements with Nagoya University may join this program.
- Applicants MUST be of senior undergraduate or graduate status during the NUSIP period (including junior undergraduates who are completing their junior program).
- Applicants who are non-native speakers of English should possess a TOEFL score of 550 <CBT =213; iBT=79>, TOEIC score of 730, an IELTS overall band score of 5.5, CEFR band B2, CET-6 score of 450, or the equivalent and should attach a copy of the official score record to the application. However, those studying full time at a university where the medium of instruction is the English language are exempt from this requirement.

Required Scanned Documents

For the following documents a scanned PDF file of the ORIGINAL (1-6) and an image file (JPEG file) of Photograph (7) should be uploaded onto the application system.

- 1. Statement of Purpose
 - Using an A4-sized PDF file(.pdf), your "Statement of Purpose" at the Nagoya University Automotive Engineering Summer Intensive Program (NUSIP) which may be written in English (minimum 400 words) should be prepared.
- Official Transcript(s) of Academic Records (to be issued in English)
 NB. Two or more transcripts should be combined into one PDF file.

- 3. Language proficiency supporting documents, i.e., TOEFL, IELTS, TOEIC, CEFR, or CET-6 score sheets. (Please enquire at nusip(at)engg.nagoya-u.ac.jp about the validity of your internationally-recognized test score if it is not listed above.).
 - NB. Two or more language scores should be combined into one PDF file.
- 4. Health Certificate (designated form).
- 5. Copy of the information page of your passport, where available.
- 6. Curriculum Vitae (CV) and Declaration of applicable specific categories (designated form).
- 7. Photograph (solid-color background)(JPEG file), showing a close-up of your full head and upper shoulders. In the photographs, you should NOT wear sunglasses/tinted glasses, or headwear, unless this is for religious or medical reasons.
